Our editorial board worked hard to make it a beautiful, informative and a complete school magazine.

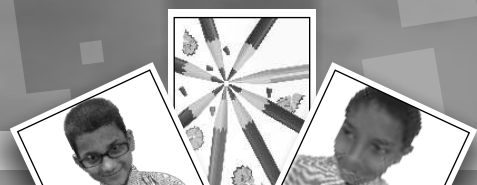

Past is just behind us, Present is in our hands, future is in our minds, let us all together make a better future.

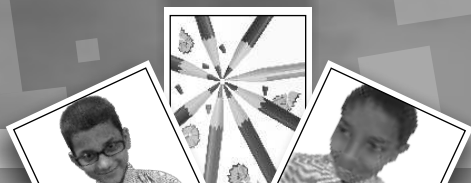

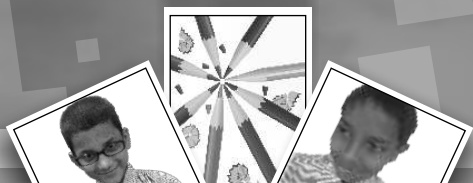

Azam of Class VIII got Participation certificates in the National Science Fair @ Chennai.

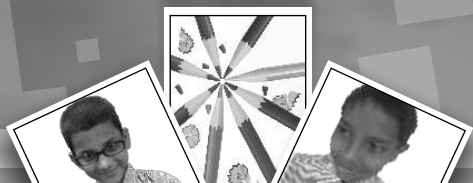

18. Neo Computer aided Education, interactive smart board, Neo-Edu-Techno Sessions and Neo Mobile science lab to make child in par with international standards.

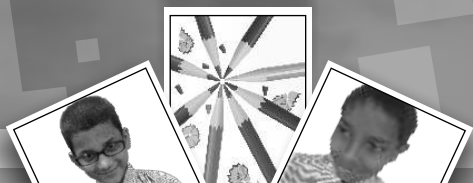

NEED for A COUNSELOR IN SCHOOL

Today's teachers, students and the parents are equally pressurized with the media, films and other societal influence on the families. We are unable to keep these sources distinctly away from the four walls of our house. So it is increasingly difficult for the parents or the school authorities to discipline the child. So professional guidance from a counselor becomes distinctly necessary.

An effective teacher has to balance time, curriculum, space, resources, behaviors, and also keep herself abreast with the dynamic changes in the educational world. Usual problems that a student and teacher confront are basically due to perception. This results into behavioral problems.

With the various pressures from all angles, will the teacher be in a position to deliver her goods? Can the school authorities manage to reach their expectations? Will the parents be in position to see their kids excel? And above all should the dreams of the students remain castles in the air?

When parents constantly try disciplining the child it becomes monotonous and the child finds it as a constant harassment.

Corporal punishment from school authorities may derive instant results, but cannot be a permanent solution. The long-term effect can be devastating to every one. Unreasonable behaviour will never achieve desirable alternatives. It can also hurt the student's physical and psychological development. This also impairs the student- teacher relationship.

The targeted results and time bound academics will surely need proper orientation.

Schools have to hire the services of a professional counselor, to put the students on the right tracks. As the students are exposed to a new face and a patient listener, they tend to come out with possible reasons for their misbehavior. The counselor will be in a position to understand the problems from all angles and enable positive results from the students. This is very essential as the formative years in a child's life are laid with a chalked out plan. Even the ruler of the roost also can be mended if a right approach is adopted. The services of the counselor work as a magic wand to reform a student to achieve a common goal. What the student does not want to share with the parents, teacher or the school authorities, he will be willing to share with a counselor.

The counselor will in turn forward remedial measures with out hurting the three groups that is, teacher, parent and the school authorities, thereby acting as a Positive catalyst. This will allow immediate rectification of a student's behavior.

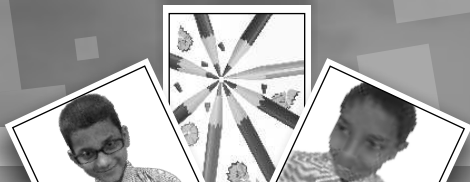
As the teacher can have oriented set of students in a class, she will be able to achieve her targets. Also the school's average performance can be raised to different heights.

I am grateful to Allah (SWT) and feel very proud of myself being a TEACHER. Through my 15 years of teaching and working in education, I experienced many

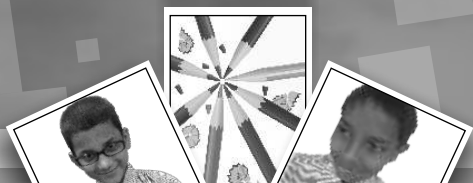

Speciality of Vegetables

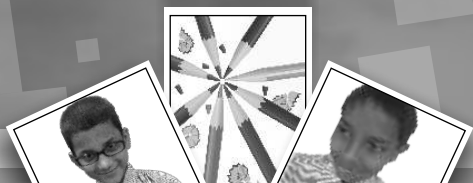

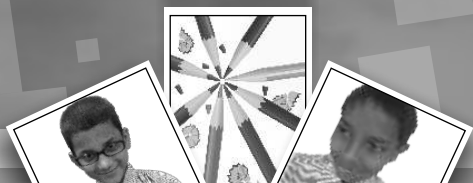
The sweetest word in this world-MOTHER

Remedies of Slow Learners

1) Physical Cause:

The Student who suffers from some defects in their physical organs may term backward poor eyesight, defective learning, inadequacy is speech like stammering dumbness, chronic disease, and pain in stomach or usually headaches, too much thin or at body always result in abnormal growth and inadequate development.

Remedy:

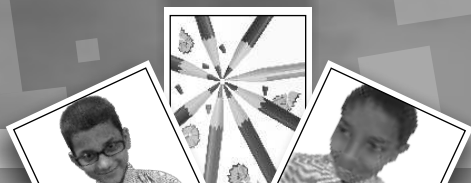
Remedy of all these came lives with the physician of doctor but some sort of physical exercise may also help the child.

2) Lack of Interest:-

Some students have little or sometimes no interest for learning mathematics. The disinterest towards the subject may be due to wrong attitudes towards the subject and faulty methods of learning in some cases, the students are forced to learn mathematics, due to over

enthusiasm ambitions of the parents.

Remedy:

Most of the mathematics which we use in our practical life is oral. The day to day sale and purchase of commodities, small transaction and exchange of the things are all made through oral mathematics. So parents can slowly inculcate the habit of sale and purchase among their children in their day to day shopping.

3) Mental Disability

The mental disability may be inborn or caused by environmental factors the child may have low IQ, mental conflict, inferiority complex, feeling of insecurity, anxiety, tension, fear, maladjustment etc.

Remedy:

Many of these mental disorders can be successfully tackled with a conscious effort attitude of affection, sympathy kindness and good rapport between teacher and parent can go a long way in this regard.

4) Irregular School Attendance:

Irregularity in attendance comes great harm to the mathematics student. It is because mathematics is a sequential subject. One Concept knowledge is dependent on the other. Once the student by some reason misses the classes he cannot understand the teaching on the following day. The gap is more widened in the coming days if the student do not avail the individual help from concern teacher.

Remedy:

Parents must see that their child is regular to school.

5) Irregular Study Habits:

Mathematics is a subject of logical sequence higher order concepts depends upon the order concepts rules and formulae are statements of relationships among these concepts. Therefore a student with irregular study will find it hard to understand and apply the mathematical laws and principles.

Remedy:

Student should plan their time table, makes proper more systematic drill and must practice for longer retention. And must take time to time reviews from concern teacher.

6) Family Background and Home Environment:

The unconsciousness atmosphere at home the negative attitude of the parents towards the subject, the pressure of the parents and so on could adversely influence the students performance in mathematics.

Remedy:

Our school gives opportunity for the parents can encourage their children to participate in recreational activities conducted by our school in the form of science fairs, seminar etc

Every fourth Saturday our school conducts activity day which is a playful method of learning subject. Students can avail this opportunity and can enjoy solving mathematical riddles

Importance of balanced diet in the Life of the student

As we start leading hectic life styles, our NUTRITION and FOOD INTAKE habits have taken a back seat. Today, when the work load for students is all time high and there is a lot of PRESSURE to perform well, it is very important for PARENTS to take care of child's food habits.

Here, I have given a few GUIDELINES in simple terms for the parents and the child to understand:

- Never eat your food while talking on the phone or watching T.V or computers.

- Wash your hands before you start eating.
- Eat very slowly and chew your food thoroughly.
- Eat food that is prepared fresh and consume it within 3 hours of cooking.
- Eat fruits whole, instead of cutting them into pieces because you lose a large number of VITAMINS.
- Never eat food which has been stored in refrigerator for a longer time.
- Buy seasonal fruits, and make sure to eat at least (3) of them daily.

A Child's daily diet should include at least

- 2 Glasses of milk.
- A balanced break fast (Idli, Dosa, Poha, Roti)
- Lunch should consist of chapatti or rice, vegetable curry, daal and a glass of butter-milk.
- A mid-Afternoon snack which is high in protein e.g. : cheese sandwich or egg white.

- Dinner should be light and taken preferably three hours before bedtime.

Good eating habits will ensure physical and mental alertness in a child throughout the day.

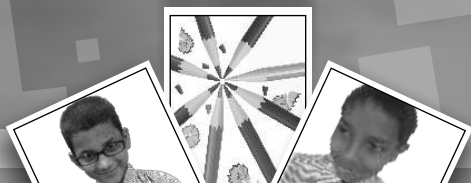

ABOUT AP FORMATION DAY

Andhra Pradesh is one of the 28 states of India situated in the country's Southeastern coast. It is India's fourth largest state by area and fifth largest by population. Its capital city is Hyderabad. Andhra Pradesh is bordered by Maharashtra, Chhattisgarh and Orissa in the North, the bay of Bengal in the east Tamil Nadu to the west. The state coastal Andhra, Terengganu, Uttar and Uttar Andhra and Rayalseema. The state most popular cities are Hyderabad, Vishakhapatnam, Vijayawada, Guntur, Warangal, and Nellore.

However telugu speaking people demanded for their long cherished visalandhra formation but people of Hyderabad state were unanimous in their demand for splitting the state in to three parts. The states reorganization commission headed by SYED FAZAL ALI heard the view of different people and organizations based on the commissions' conclusion the congress party high command preferred visaldandhra and enlarged the state by including nine telugu speaking districts of Hyderabad state to eleven districts of Andhra State to form Andhra Pradesh with 20 districts. In the process, the Hyderabad state was split among Maharashtra, Karnataka and Andhra State. Aurangabad division merged with Maharashtra and Gulbarga division merged with Karnataka. The rest of the two division of the state Gulshanabad or Medak and Naziabad merged with Andhra State thus, the sate of A.P emerged merging all the districts of Coastal Andhra, Rayalseema and Telangana.

On November 01, 1956 with NeelamSajiva Reddy as the ChiefMinister and C.M Trivedi as the

Governor.

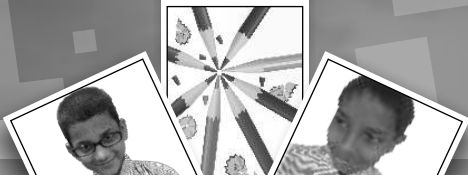
FOUR SEASONS

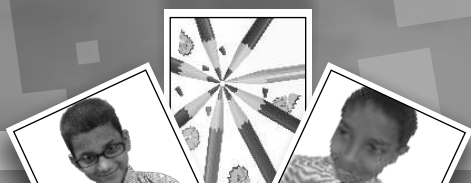
This will not only help the donors to contribute for the cause of education but also helps to live their passionate dream of serving

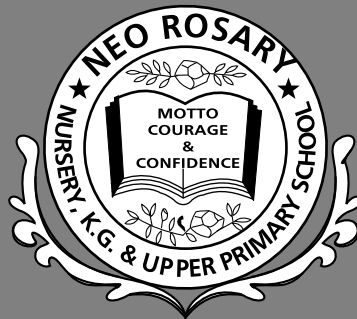
Rules and Regulations.
